

The Henry County Education Fund ("Fund") is a community-based initiative born from the 2022 Bicentennial Celebration to positively impact the area's future residents. The Fund is held by the Henry County Community Foundation. The initial investment is from the 2022 Bicentennial Celebration.

Specifically, the Fund's initial goal is to improve the accessibility and completion of post secondary certificates through lvy Tech Community College, with a preference for certificates offered at lvy Tech Henry County (3325 State Road 3 in New Castle).

The initial goal is to fund 2 to 4 scholarships in 2024. The Fund will offer last dollar scholarships for the completion of certificates.

The long-term goal is to fund 100 + scholarships by 2032, Henry County's 210th Birthday.

Another long-term goal is to have the capacity to offer scholarships for degrees.

   2.0 GPA
- Residents of Henry County with a high school degree or equivalent
- Adults employed in Henry County with a high school degree or equivalent

## What is a Last Dollar Scholarship?

The Fund provides financial assistance to offset tuition and mandatory fees associated after gift aid has been credited to tuition and mandatory fees within Federal and State regulations. "Gift aid" is defined as Pell, Indiana state grant awards and any other scholarships. Federal and state aid are applied to the student's account first, the Fund's Scholarship is applied to any remaining balance after all other aid has been exhausted.
